IMPORTANT DATES

Fall Semester

Nomination deadline: 1 June Application deadline: 15 June

Semester period: September - December

Spring Semester

Nomination deadline: 1 November Application deadline: 15 November Semester period: January - April

APPLICATION PROCESS

Nominated students are invited to complete their online application form and choose their courses.

Acceptance letters are emailed to students and copied to their local coordinator.

ARRIVAL & ORIENTATION

Buses and taxis are available from the airport and the train station.

A mandatory welcome day followed by an orientation programme is organised to discover Pau and its region.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Nomination is done by the local coordinator through a dedicated form.

Programmes and academic information are available on our website.

BEFORE MOBILTY

Our international office advises students on visa procedure, search for housing, banking partners and compulsory insurance policies.

Students receive their login and password to access ESC Pau Business School digital system.

Application process for exchange students

Nominated students receive an email confirming their nomination and inviting them to complete their online form.

Required documents for application are:

- passport/identity card
- identity photo for student card
- last transcript of records
- B1 level language proficiency depending on programme (EN/FR)
- course registration form duly completed
- proof of health insurance

Academic regulations

Students cannot mix courses from different programmes due to timetable collisions.

According to the academic regulations of ESC Pau Business School, an average of 10 out of 20 is the pass grade.

Courses can be evaluated in different ways (final exam and/or continuous assessment)

Resit exams are organized at the end of the exchange period.

Students are able to download their transcripts of records from their ESC Pau Business School intranet within 2 months after the end of the semester. Certified copies can be sent to local coordinators upon request.

Find an accommodation

Students have the possibility to be housed in an apartment through ESC Pau Business School own platform. Login and password are sent once their application is validated.

Depending on availabilities, the international office manages limited offers in public student residences but does not guaranty the type of housing.

Health insurance

A proof of health insurance covering medical, hospital, accident and repatriation expenses will be requested to all students.

- European students:
 - --> European Health Insurance Card + repatriation insurance (not covered by EHIC)
- Non-European students:
 - --> private health insurance certificate for the whole stay abroad

Other mandatory insurances

All students are requested to subscribe to compulsory insurance policies:

- housing insurance for covering your
 accommodation against theft and other damage
 that you may cause or suffer
- civil liability insurance, called in France
 "Responsabilité civile", indispensable for damage
 that you may unintentionally cause to third parties
 in your private life.
