<p>Application procedure</p>	<p>Nomination is done in SoleMove, and the partners should have the credentials there. If not, please contact incoming@utu.fi</p> <p>Nominated students will automatically receive an application email with application instructions, when the application period begins.</p> <p>The student should have studied 2 years when applying to the exchange at UTU. If s/he wishes to complete Master level studies at UTU, the student should be a Master student or in the last years of her/his Bachelor studies.</p>
<p>Enclosures</p>	<p>Student will enclose to the application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • transcript of records in English • English certificate • copy of the passport/ ID
<p>Language Requirements</p>	<p>University of Turku requires a B2 level in English.</p> <p>NB! The language certificate should not be more than 2 years old at the time the student is submitting it.</p> <p>Accepted language tests: https://www.utu.fi/en/study-at-utu/how-to-apply-for-exchange-studies → language certificate</p>
<p>Visa procedure</p>	<p>A Residence Permit is required for all non-EU/EEA citizens staying in Finland for longer than 3 months.</p> <p>In the official acceptance email there will be the information, how to apply the residence permit to Finland. . <p>Housing</p>	<p>www.utu.fi/housing</p> <p>The demand for student housing in Turku is extremely high. Therefore we welcome students to come during Spring semester, since there will be more housing available for exchange students.</p>
<p>Transcript of records</p>	<p>Incoming: The transcript is sent to the student electronically by email, with digital stamp and signature. No hard copies are sent by postal mail.
