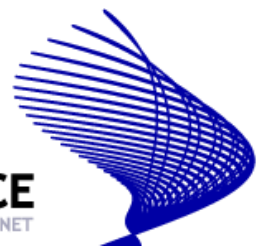

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## INTRODUCTION

The SCIP project (“Causes and Consequences of Socio-Cultural Integration Processes among New Immigrants in Europe”) is a panel study co-ordinated by Claudia Diehl (University of Konstanz), together with researchers at Bamberg University, Göttingen University, the Netherlands Institute for Social Research, Utrecht University, Essex University, the London School of Economics and Social Sciences, Trinity College Dublin, and the Economic and Social Research Institute, and funded by the NORFACE research programme on Migration in Europe – Social, Economic, Cultural and Policy Dynamics.

This document presents the survey instrument used in the second wave, conducted in 2012/2013. After 15-18 months, migrants who participated in the first study were re-contacted and interviewed with as a similar survey instrument including a wide range of questions concerning their household situation, social networks, cultural attitudes, religious practices, socio-economic performance and future migration plans. New migrants’ mobility patterns between the first and second wave were captured by questions relating to trips back home, remigration plans or plans to migrate to a third country. Some variables relating to respondents’ migration history in wave one were imported to wave two in order to follow up on their individual experiences.

The second wave was carried out by using computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI), an online survey (CAWI) and personal interviews (CAPI, in Germany only). In all three modes, the same questionnaire was used, although the online survey (CAWI) has been slightly redesigned; thus, comments for interviewers were removed, additional explanations and hints for the respondent were added (ie. “Mark all that apply” or “Please choose the closest”) and both “refused” and “don’t know” options were deleted in most of the questions. In some cases, where answer options were supposed to be coded but not read out by an interviewer, open answer questions were used to avoid bias (section on perceived discrimination).

While all interviews were conducted in the respective first language, the document presents the English language version of CATI questionnaire only.

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## USER INSTRUCTIONS

The SCIP questionnaire document presents the survey instrument used by all countries in the second wave, conducted in 2012/2013. Similarly as for the first wave, this document is designed not only to present an overview of all questions but also to facilitate use of the SCIP dataset. Therefore, it includes questions wording, interviewer instructions and answer categories as well as information on variable names, labels and values, on filters, and on country-specific questions which help users navigate the datasets of each country. The following chart gives instructions on how to read the information contained in the questionnaire.
