Who are we?

The Erasmus Mundus Programme "**Euroculture**: Society, Politics and Culture in a Global Context" is an **international program**, in which various disciplines, eight well-known European and four non-EU universities participate. Its aim is to prepare graduates from Europe and third-countries for professions in which knowledge of present-day Europe and European Union institutions are of relevance. The Programme is **fully taught in English**.

- Creativity and good social communication skills
- Local knowledge of advantage

The internship is not paid but can be accounted for; an enrollment at a university is required
