

APPLICATION PROCESS

For partner institutions:

- Nominate students online via the SEB nomination platform.
- Nomination instructions are sent to verified contacts of SEB partner institutions.
- We accept only officially nominated students; freemover students are not eligible.
- Partners should inform us upon nomination if a student has an approved learning disability status. Each request is individually reviewed, and accommodations are provided if possible.

Winter semester | Full year: from 1 March to 1 May Spring semester: from 1 September to 1 November

REQUIREMENTS

LANGUAGE

Students must provide proof of English proficiency at B2 level (CEFR) via one of the following:

- Transcript of Records listing English skills.
- Language Certificate with CEFR scale, issued by home institution.
- TOEFL (79) or IELTS (6.0) certificate.

ACADEMIC

 No specific academic requirements; we trust partner institutions to nominate suitable students.

ACCOMMODATION

- SEB does not provide or guarantee accommodation.
- UL Student Organization's International Office and Erasmus Student Network provide resources for private housing.
- Housing is seasonal; students are advised to book temporary accommodation for their first week in Ljubljana.


