Dorothea Schlözer-Programme CAREER COACHING FOR FEMALE POSTDOCS NEW CALL 2025

You are a female postdoc at Göttingen University or at the Göttingen Campus and aim at a leading position in science?

The Dorothea Schlözer career coaching for postdocs will promote your career development and will prepare you for a leading role in research and academia. The one-year intensive programme provides training and coaching in key academic skills as well as practical career relevant knowledge relating to international science management, research funding, leadership skills, appointment procedures and networking for female scientists and scholars of different disciplines. The programme enhances career development in a flexible and individual manner: It combines a wide range of methods (individual and group coaching, workshops and trainings) as well as networking options.

Target group

The programme is open for all female postdocs, leaders of junior research groups and junior professors at Göttingen University and the Göttingen Campus. In terms of the empowerment of women, the Dorothea Schlözer Programme is aimed at all female scientists and all people identifying themselves as such.

Requirements

Active participation is compulsory. Furthermore, your supervisor supports your participation in the programme and will release you from work on the workshop, training or coaching days (minimum four full-day workshops and four half-day coaching).

The programme will start with an obligatory **kick-off workshop** in **March 2025 (date to be announced)**. There will also be a joint opening event together with the participants of the Dorothea Schlözer mentoring programme on **March 20th**, **2025**.

The workshops are free of charge. The costs incurred for materials, drinks and food during the workshops amount to a total of **80 Euros** per person and are to be paid in advance.

Please note: The workshops are mainly offered in English, but also some in German. For the coaching, two groups – one in German, one in English (dependent on the language skills of the participants) – will be provided.

Application

If you are interested, you are invited to apply by handing in the following documents as one single pdf:

- 1. Letter setting out your motivation for participation and stating your envisaged future career
- 2. Brief description of your current research project with information on the state of your work
- 3. Curriculum vitae including a list of publications

We would like to point out that the submission of the application constitutes consent under data protection law for us to process your applicant data.
